Our centre is located in a quiet residential suburb at the University of East London Docklands Campus, next to the river Thames with views of the iconic London skyline.

The residence buildings are modern with single en-suite rooms spread across extensive grounds with an outdoor gym and basketball court for student use. Students can easy access central London to explore all the attractions of the bustling capital city.

Living

- Several residence buildings with single en-suite rooms arranged in flats of 4 to 6 students
- Each flat has got a communal room
- Room furniture includes a wardrobe, desk and chair
- Rooms and common rooms are cleaned weekly
- Laundry available in Longbridge House, cleaning is £2.40 per wash and drying is £1.00 per cycle
- Meals are served in a large dining hall
- Wi-Fi throughout accommodation
- A deposit of £30 is required upon arrival, replacement of lost room key is £180
- Two DLR train stations are located on the campus and take students straight into London in 30 minutes



Dining & facilities

Meals served in large and modern self-service dining hall in the main building.

Breakfast

Continental including juice, coffee, toast, cereal and fruit – hot breakfast on Fridays.

Lunch

2 courses, 3 options including vegetarian.
Packed lunches (provided at weekends): water, fruit, sandwich, crisps and biscuits/cake.

Evening Meal

2 courses, 3 options including vegetarian and halal option.

Snacks

There are several cafés on campus for the purchase of snacks, drinks and confectionery.

Facilities

- Multi-purpose sports hall
- Outdoor gym and basketball court
- Astro turf football pitch
- Outdoor areas for games and activities, including Beckton Park
- Cash machine (ATM)
- Several cafés and shops



Learning

- Taught by friendly and professional English teachers
- 20 x 45 minute lessons per week morning or afternoon
- Placement test on day 1 to ensure students in appropriate level
- Maximum 17 students per class
- Students will be placed in an international class with students of different nationalities
- Spacious classrooms with projectors
- Classrooms are located across the main University building
- Curriculum with emphasis on communication skills
- Materials included as well as an end of course report ans a certificate
- Trinity exam preparation available



Programme

Arrival

Students will be welcomed upon arrival at East Building where they will register and get their room keys and can check-in to their rooms.

Welcome

On the first evening there will be a welcome activity which is designed to ensure students have the opportunity to meet staff and other students and get to know more about the campus, its facilities and useful information which will help them during their stay.

Activities

Activities are organised in between lessons and during evenings. These activities could be on-site or near to the centre. These may include:

- **Sports** such as football, mini Olympics, rounders, table tennis, volleyball and basketball
- **Daytime activities** such as scavenger hunts and drama workshops
- **Evening activities** such as karaoke, talent show, and team games

Excursions and Trips



Our students get to explore exciting places around London every weekday, they visit places such as: The British Museum, St Paul’s Cathedral, Tower of London, Oxford street shopping and The National Gallery.



Brighton: Enjoy this vibrant popular seaside city with beautiful architecture and visit The Sea Life Centre and The Palace Pier

Canterbury: visit this UNESCO World Heritage Site, one of the most visited cities in the UK with medieval buildings and enjoy the gothic architecture of Canterbury Cathedral.

Cambridge: explore this iconic University city and visit King’s College



Thorpe Park: enjoy extreme rides and attractions at this popular theme park Hampton Court: the magnificent home of Henry VIII

Windsor Castle: Windsor Castle is the oldest and largest inhabited castle in the world. It has been the family home of British kings and queens for almost 1,000 years and is today one of the official residences of His Majesty The King.

Oxford: explore this iconic University city and its famous colleges and visit one of them, free entrance

London evening activity: The London Eye experience or Optional Musical
